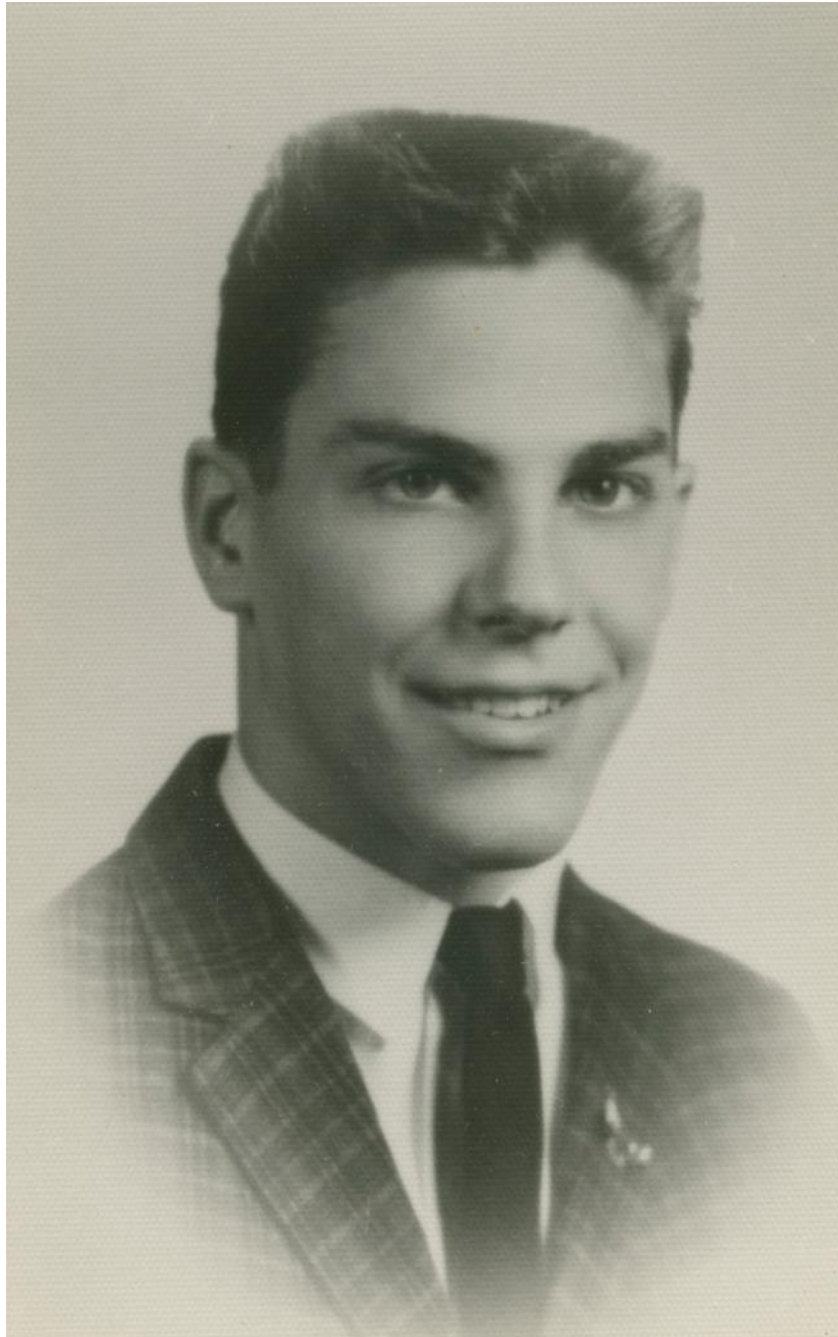

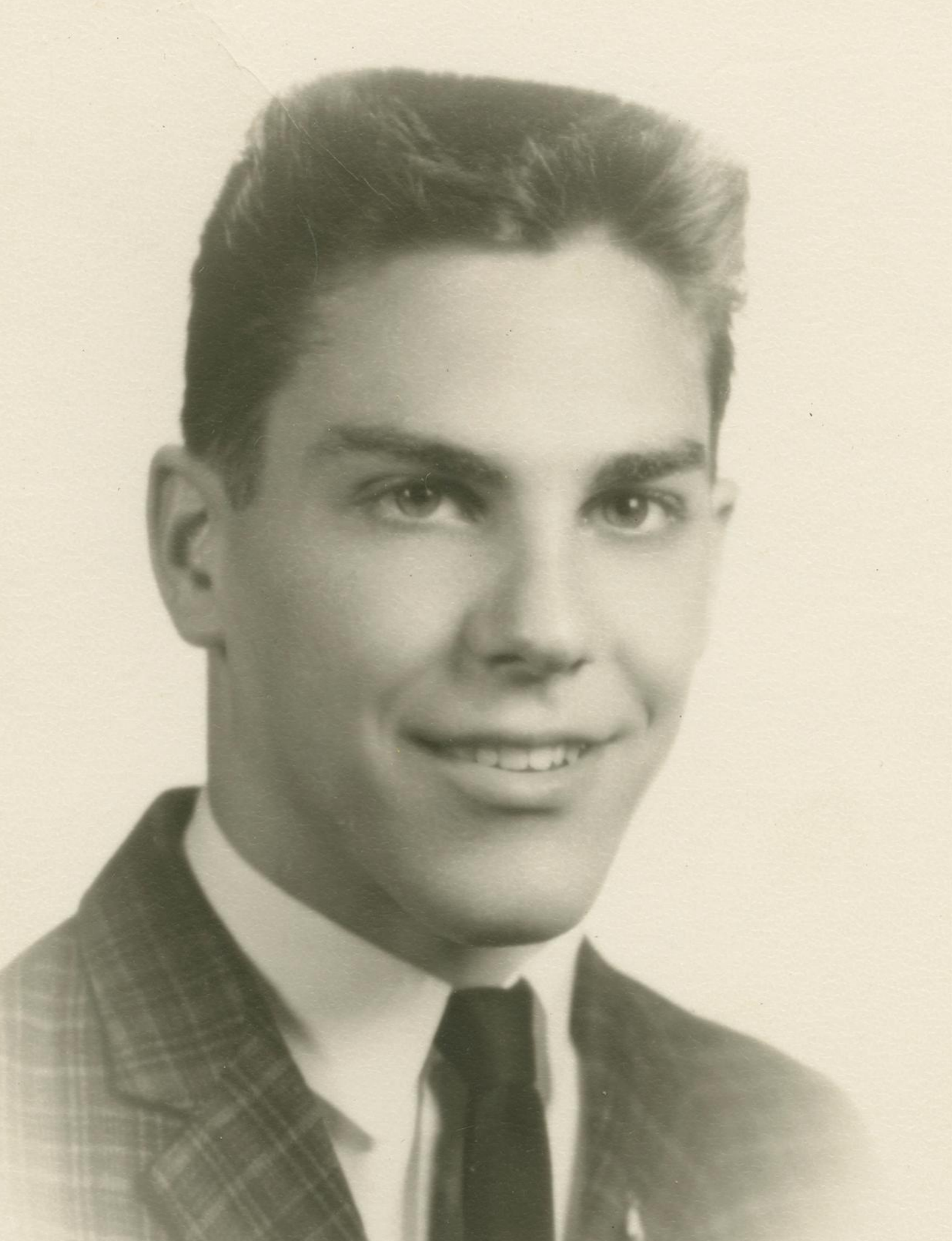


Ode to Home

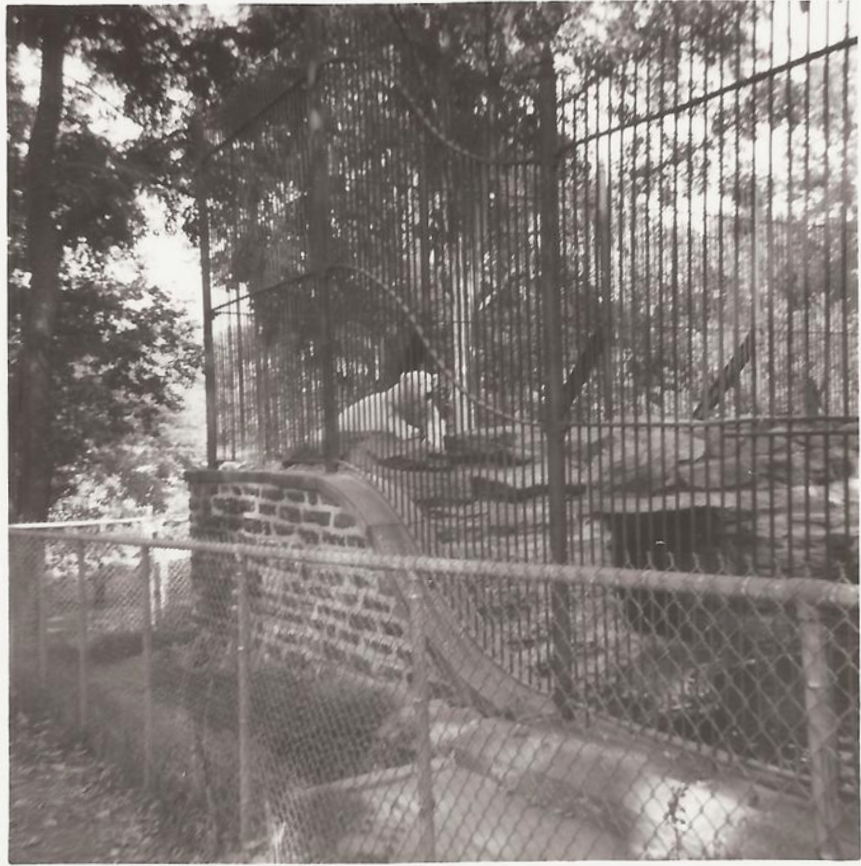

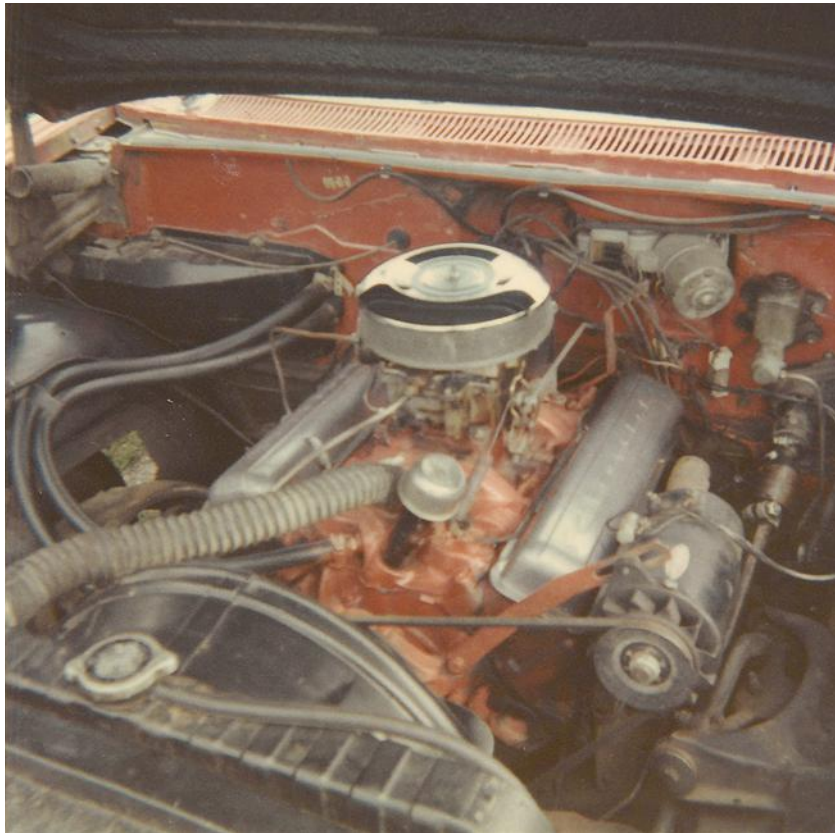

Dear Soccer Player;

Practice sessions for the 1962 Southern Lehigh soccer team will begin on Monday, August 27 at 9:00 A.M. Practice sessions will be held at the school.

You will need to bring your gym uniform and a towel. You will have to bring towels until towel service begins in gym classes.

Until the beginning of school; practice sessions will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 11:30 A.M. Beginning September 4, the day after Labor Day, until the end of the season, practice sessions will begin at 3:00 P.M. and last until 5:00 or 5:30 P.M.

We have a twelve game schedule this year. Six games are at home and six are away. We open on Sept. 13 at home against North Penn, and we close on Oct. 26 at Wilson Boro. Soccer in no way interferes with winter sports which cannot begin practice until Nov. 1.

If you have friends interested in playing on the team, please bring them along. We need managers too.

I hope to see you on Aug. 27 and hope that you are willing to do all that is required to help make a successful team. Last year was a disappointing season. I am sure we will do much better this year.

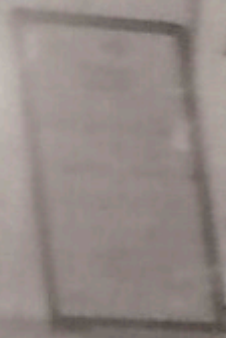
